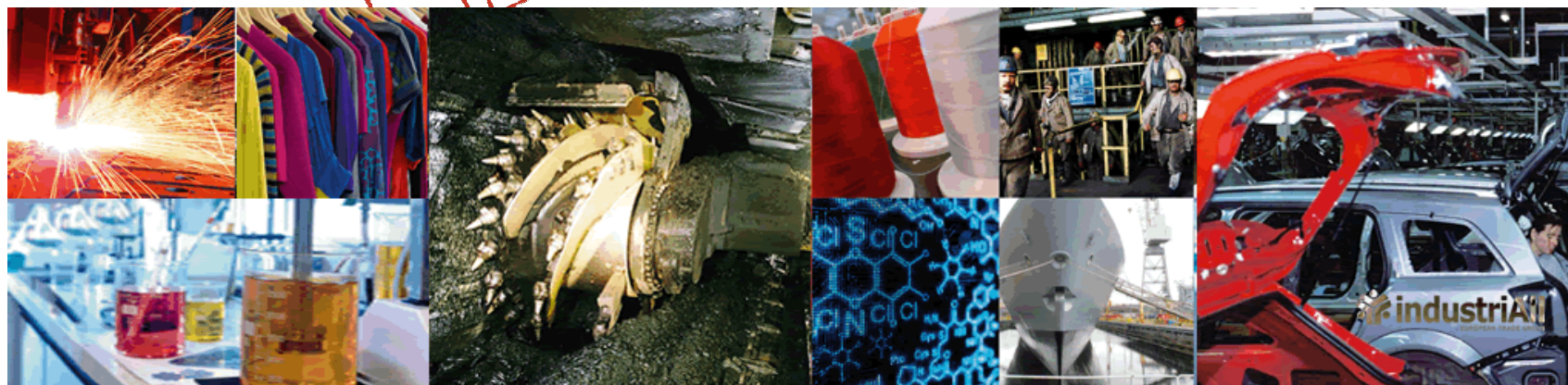

industriAll Project on Industrial Policy in South East Europe

- We need a **sustainable industrial policy** in South East Europe
- Without attracting companies/investments to SEE we do not see much scope for improvement (e.g. organizing workers to build stronger trade unions)
- **Objective of the project** is the development of a Trade Union action plan on IP in joint cooperation with the trade unions
- Supported by FES Belgrade

industriAll Project on Industrial Policy in South East Europe - Activities

- June 2013: Kick-off conference: the day after industriAll General SEE Region Meeting in Bucharest
- Exchange of ideas, identifying indicators for a national questionnaire , defining further steps in our IP project
- Until June 2014: Analysis of IP, shortcomings and chances for growth in SEE by experts: 1 expert from SEE (N.N.) and 1 industriAll expert (Mischa Terzyk in coordination with Standing Working Party Industrial Policy)

industriAll Project on Industrial Policy in South East Europe - Activities

- Sept 2013 - June 2014: Sub-regional workshops on specific country problems, labour relations and TU role in shaping industrial policy → identifying an IP agenda
- October 2014: industriAll Europe Conference on IP in SEE:
 - ✓ Collecting findings of sub-regional workshops
 - ✓ Final reports of experts
 - ✓ Definition of action plan for the future

industriAll ITC-ILO Project: Strengthening Social Dialogue on national and European level

- Feb 2013 Training of Trainers Workshop successful: 37 participants from 15 countries
- Regional workshops:
 - SEE: 1-2 July 2013 in Zagreb
 - Baltic: 20-21 August in Vilnius
 - CEE: 16-17 September in Prague
 - Turkey: 19-20 September in Istanbul or Brussels (tbc.)
- Final Conference: 6-7 November in Belgrade or Brussels (tbc.)
